



## Want to graduate college with less debt?

If you're an individual pursuing a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree in a manufacturing-related field, Questa can help fund your education. You could receive up to \$10,000 for a certificate or associate (2-year) degree, or \$20,000 for a bachelor's (4-year) degree (\$5,000 per year/\$2,500 per semester). Our loan is up to 75% forgivable\* when you graduate and live and work in Northeast Indiana for five years after graduation.

**Fields of study may include:** Advanced Manufacturing, Electrical Engineering, Computer Technology, Engineering, Business Management, Accounting, Finance, Human Resources, Entrepreneurship, Machine Tool Technology, Sales, Supply Chain Management

### Program requirements

- Resident of Northeast Indiana (counties include: Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, LaGrange, Kosciusko, Noble, Steuben, Wabash, Wells, and Whitley)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater is preferred
- Accepted by and planning to attend an accredited, not-for-profit college or university in Indiana
- Enrolled as either a part-time (6+ credit hours) or full-time student (12 credit+ credit hours)

\*Loan forgiveness options may vary. 50% of our loan is forgiven when a scholar lives and works in Northeast Indiana for five years after graduation. An additional 25% may be forgiven when a scholar graduates from one of our partner schools.
