



Want to graduate college with less debt?

We can help — with a forgivable loan designed to help you graduate with an affordable education.

If you're a current high school senior or college freshman from Grant County, Questa Education Foundation and the Community Foundation of Grant County will help fund your postsecondary education, up to \$20,000 for a bachelor's (4-year) degree, or \$10,000 for an associate (2-year) degree (\$5,000 per year/\$2,500 per semester). Our loan is 50% forgivable when you graduate and live in Grant County for five years after graduation. (*You can work in any county after graduation!*)

Program requirements

- Be a recent high school graduate from Grant County (are a current high school senior graduating in spring 2024; or a current college freshman)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater is preferred
- Completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Accepted by and planning to attend an accredited, not-for-profit college or university in Indiana

To apply for your forgivable loan, scan the QR code to create an account. Choose the Traditional Scholars application and upload your required documents, including a high school/college transcript, Financial Aid Summary after completing your FAFSA, and financial aid notification from your intended college.
