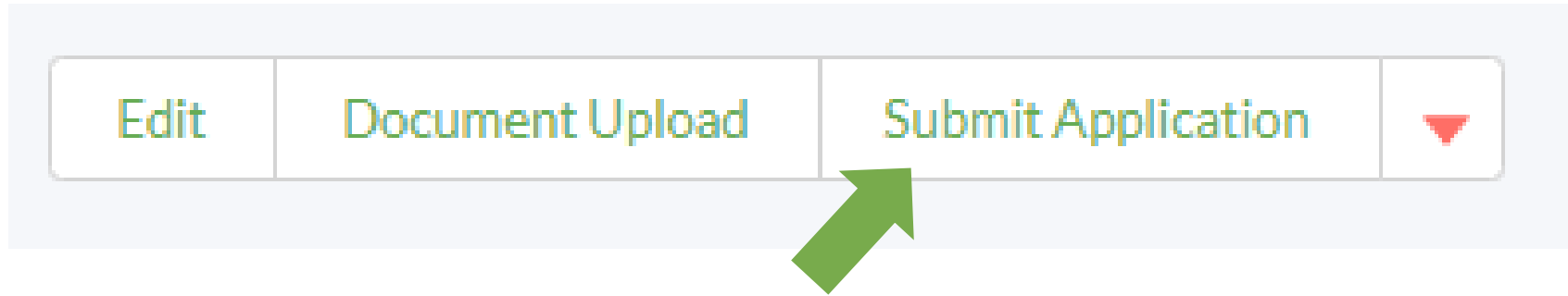

1. Financial Aid Notification (or Financial Aid Award Letter) from your college
 - If you have not yet received your financial aid notification, upload the standard cost of attendance found on the college's website.
2. Unofficial High School or College Transcript (Students in their first year of college should upload a college transcript that includes their Fall 2023 grades.)
3. FAFSA Submission Summary (or confirmation email once your FAFSA has been completed – estimated SAI must be included)

If you do not intend to file the FAFSA or your estimated SAI is listed as 'Cannot Calculate' in your FAFSA confirmation email, you must complete the Financial Aid Estimator and upload a screenshot or PDF of your results: <https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/>.
