Financial Aid Estimator

If you are not planning to file FAFSA Questa will need for you to complete a Financial Aid Estimator and upload the summary screenshot of PDF for this application. https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/

In the Financial section, you'll list your SAI (Student Aid Index) from the FAFSA. This can be found on your FAFSA Submission Summary. If you have not yet received your FAFSA Submission Summary, you should have received a confirmation email shortly after submitting your FAFSA form. This should list an estimated SAI that you can refer to while your FAFSA is still processing.

If you do not intend to file the FAFSA or you have not yet received your SAI, you will need to complete the Financial Aid Estimator and upload a screenshot or PDF of your results under the 'Document Upload' section of the application: <u>https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/</u>.

If there is anything else you'd like to share with our review committee regarding your family's financial status, please list that information in the 'Family Financial Details' field.

Once you submit your application, your references will receive an email from us requesting a recommendation on your behalf. If they are not finding this email in their inbox, please remind them to check their spam folder.

You can check the 'Recommendation Status' section after you submit to see if your references have completed their recommendations.

Once you complete the Application page, scroll back to the top and click the 'Document Upload' button.

Document Upload

File will be saved when you click Done after each upload. All uploads must be complete to submit application.

Financial Aid Notification - Typically found on your college portal financial page. Notification will list your expected college costs and any financial aid.



Most Recent Unofficial Transcript (high school seniors will upload a high school transcript; college students will upload a college transcript)



FAFSA - Confirmation email or Submission summary.

Financial Aid Estimator (Required when not filing FAFSA)



You'll need to upload:

- 1. Financial Aid Notification (or Financial Aid Award Letter) from your college
 - If you have not yet received your financial aid notification, upload the standard cost of attendance found on the college's website.
- 2. Unofficial High School or College Transcript (Students in their first year of college should upload a college transcript that includes their Fall 2023 grades.)
- FAFSA Submission Summary (or confirmation email once your FAFSA has been completed – estimated SAI must be included)

If you do not intend to file the FAFSA or your estimated SAI is listed as 'Cannot Calculate' in your FAFSA confirmation email, you must complete the Financial Aid Estimator and upload a screenshot or PDF of your results: <u>https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/</u>.



Don't forget to click the 'Submit Application' button when all information and documents are complete!

Remember: You're not done yet! Don't forget to follow up with your references to make sure they complete their recommendations.
