

## Want to graduate college with less debt?

We can help — with a forgivable loan designed to help you finish your education with less debt.

If you're a current high school senior or college freshman, Questa will help fund your postsecondary education, up to \$20,000 for a bachelor's (4-year) degree, or \$10,000 for a certificate or associate (2-year) degree (\$5,000 per year/\$2,500 per semester). Our loan is up to 75% forgivable\* when you graduate and live and work in Northeast Indiana for five years after graduation.

## **Program requirements**

- Be a recent high school graduate from Northeast Indiana (counties include: Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, LaGrange, Kosciusko, Noble, Steuben, Wabash, Wells, and Whitley)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater is preferred
- Completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Accepted by and planning to attend an accredited, not-for-profit college or university in Indiana
- Enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more) per semester



TRADITIONAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM

\*Loan forgiveness options may vary. 50% of our loan is forgiven when a scholar lives and works in Northeast Indiana for five years after graduation. An additional 25% may be forgiven when a scholar graduates from one of our partner schools.

## Start your application!

To apply for your forgivable loan, scan the QR code to create an account. Choose the Traditional Scholars application and upload your required documents, including a high school/college transcript, FAFSA Submission Summary (or confirmation email after completing your FAFSA - estimated SAI must be included), and financial aid notification from your intended college.

If you need to finish later, simply save your application and you'll be able to re-visit it at any time.
