



## Want to graduate college with less debt?

We can help — with a forgivable loan designed to help you finish your education with less debt.

If you're an individual pursuing a degree in a healthcare-related field, Questa, in partnership with the K21 Health Foundation, can help fund your education. High school seniors, current college freshmen, and adult learners from Kosciusko County can receive up to \$5,000 per year (\$2,500 per semester) that is up to 75%\* forgivable.

### Program requirements

- Be a resident of Kosciusko County
- Seeking a bachelor degree
- Planning on majoring in healthcare-related fields
- Accepted by and planning to attend an accredited, not-for-profit college or university in Indiana
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater is preferred for traditional students
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater is preferred for contemporary students

\*Loan forgiveness options may vary. 50% of our loan is forgiven when a scholar graduates with their degree in a healthcare-related field and anticipates living and working in Northeast Indiana. An additional 25% may be forgiven when a scholar graduates from one of our partner schools.

High school seniors and college freshmen seeking college funding for the upcoming fall are encouraged to apply to the Traditional Scholars Program.

Application open December 1 - March 15.

All other returning students and adult learners can apply through the Contemporary Scholars Program, open year-round.

**Eligible fields may include:** Clinical Laboratory Technologists/Technicians, Communication Disorders Sciences and Services, Dental Hygienists/Technology, Diagnostic Medical Sonographers, Cardiovascular Technologists/Technicians, Dietitians and Nutritionists, Health Science, Health & Exercise Science, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Rehabilitation Sciences, Medical Imaging Radiologic Technology/Sonography, Medical Assisting Services, Pre-Chiropractic, Pre-Dentistry, Pre-Medicine: Biology or Chemistry, Pre-Optometry, Pre-Physician Assistant, Pre-Pharmacy, Registered Nurses
